Project Description

This project involves a minor expansion of the Allen Junction Substation. The Applicant needs to install a second transformer, breaker and associated bus work to alleviate low voltages on the nearby 138 kV system. The expansion would be approximately 25,000 square feet, representing a 4% increase in the substation's footprint. The existing fence would be expanded to the southwest to accommodate the 116 by 216-foot substation addition.

Site Description

The proposed expansion area is currently being maintained as a mowed lawn. No new easements are necessary to complete the project. The entire project would be confined to the Applicant's property.

Conclusion

Access is readily available for construction. No significant vegetative clearing is required. The construction of this project should pose only minimal negative social and ecological impacts.
