ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) This civil forfeiture case was filed on April 12, 2013, by Brian Smith (respondent). Thereafter, a prehearing conference was held and a hearing was scheduled in the matter.
- (2) On June 18, 2013, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a notice of dismissal in the case. In the notice of dismissal, Staff stated that, after a review of the facts, and further investigation and discussion with the Ohio Highway Patrol (Patrol), it agrees with the Patrol that further prosecution of the alleged violation is not warranted and that the violation should be deleted. Accordingly, Staff requested that the Commission dismiss the case and close the record.
- (3) In view of Staff's notice of dismissal, this case should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Case No. 13-895-TR-CVF be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the violation be removed from the respondent's history of violations. It is, further.


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


