ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), the Commission staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon Timothy J. Drumm (Drumm) alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On April 1, 2013, Drumm filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) A prehearing settlement conference was held on May 16, 2013.
- (4) By entry issued June 12, 2013, this case was scheduled for hearing on July 23, 2013.
- (5) On July 23, 2013, Staff filed correspondence in the docket indicating that the parties have reached a settlement in principle and requests an indefinite continuance pending the filing of the settlement agreement. Staff requests that the proceeding remain open in the event the agreement is not received within the next ten days.
- (6) In light of the correspondence filed by Staff, the attorney examiner finds that this matter should be continued. Accordingly, the hearing in this proceeding, if necessary, should be continued to a date to be established by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the hearing scheduled for July 23, 2013, be continued to a date to be established by subsequent entry. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
