ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 14, 2012, American Broadband and Telecommunications Company (American Broadband or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T) concerning a billing dispute.
- (2) Since the filing of the complaint, the parties have requested and the attorney examiner has granted several continuances to allow the parties an opportunity to resolve the dispute through negotiation.
- (3) The parties have requested that this matter be scheduled for a mediated settlement conference.
- (4) By request of the parties, this matter shall be scheduled for a settlement conference. The purpose of the settlement conference will be to facilitate the resolution of this complaint in lieu of an evidentiary hearing. In accordance with Rule 4901-1-26, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), any statement made in an attempt to settle this matter without the need for an evidentiary hearing will not generally be admissible to prove liability or invalidity of a claim. An attorney examiner from the Commission's legal department will assist in the settlement process.

- (5) All parties attending the conference shall be prepared to discuss settlement of the issues raised and shall have the requisite authority to settle those issues. In addition, parties attending the settlement conference should bring with them all documents relevant to this matter.
- (6) The settlement conference shall be held on August 20, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 1247 in the offices of the Commission, 12th Floor, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a settlement conference be held on August 20, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 1247 in the offices of the Commission, 12th Floor, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
