Notice is hereby given that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has scheduled an evidentiary hearing in Case No. 83-444-TP-CO1 to begin Wednesday. September 28. 1983, to consider the merits of a proposal of the Commission's Staff relative to the appropriate format, structure, and methodology to be utilized by telephone companies engaged in providing local exchange service in arriving at Intrastate access charges in the Stafe of Ohio. The hearing will begin with the taking of any sworn or unswarn public testimony or comments, at the conclusion of which testimony sponsored by the Staff and intervenors will commence. An access charge is the mechanism by which all local exchange carriers will recover revenues associated with the provision of facilities to originate and terminute interexchange traific after January 1, 1984, and will replace the traditional fall settlements process previously utilized by telechane componies in recovering such revenues. Adoption of an intrastate access charge program may result in an increase in charges to subscribers of telephane service in Ohio. Such an increase in charges could result either through a subscriber's local exchange carrier filling a concurrence in the tariffs of same other local exchange carrier.
