## Dear Honorable Sarah Parrot:

On July 19, 2013, Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. (Applicant) filed a motion for waiver. Applicant requested a waiver of Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 4906-5-04(A) that requires the alternate route have not more than twenty percent (20%) in common with the preferred route. The Staff of the Ohio Power Siting Board (Staff) does not object to the requested waiver, but reserves the right to require information from the Applicant in areas covered by the requested waiver if Staff determines it to be necessary during the course of the investigation. The Staff also reserves the right to investigate and contest all other issues presented in the application.
