## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 26, 2013, Donald Sindledecker (Mr. Sindledecker) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison), contending that he has been overbilled because the estimates of his usage are excessively high.
- (2) Ohio Edison answered on April 15, 2013, by stating that it had obtained actual readings of Mr. Sindledecker's meter during September, October, and December 2012, and January and April 2013. Ohio Edison added that the estimated usage is reconciled with actual usage as shown in the next month's meter reading, so ultimately there is no overcharge.
- (3) On April 26, 2013, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a May 21, 2013, settlement conference. Mr. Sindledecker did not attend the conference, nor did he provide a reason for failing to attend.
- (4) By entry issued June 4, 2013, the attorney examiner rescheduled the settlement conference to July 2, 2013.
- (5) Mr. Sindledecker filed a letter on June 22, 2013, requesting that his complaint be dismissed.
- (6) The Commission finds that the request to dismiss the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request to dismiss the complaint is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
