ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), the Commission Staff (Staff) served a notice of preliminary determination upon Rick Tomlison Trucking (Tomlison) alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On March 20, 2013, Tomlison filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) On July 19, 2013, Staff filed a motion to dismiss the case. Staff provides that Tomlison has paid in full the forfeiture assessed, and this proceeding should be terminated in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-22, O.A.C.
- (4) The Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss the case is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the case is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


