ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 30, 2013, Robert Radcliffe requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) The parties participated in a prehearing conference on May 30, 2013.
- (3) On August 23, 2013, Staff filed a motion to dismiss. In the motion, Staff indicates that Mr. Radcliffe has paid the civil forfeiture in full. Accordingly, Staff requests dismissal of the case.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-22, O.A.C., provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation. Therefore, the Commission finds that Staff's request to dismiss the case is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss this case is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.




