The Commission finds:

- (1) On February 25, 2013, Fredy A. Barrera (Complainant) filed a complaint against Aqua Ohio Inc. (Aqua) to contest his bills for the period November 2012 to January 2013. He alleged that Aqua's billing methodology is not clear.
- (2) On March 18, 2013, Aqua filed an answer in which it denied the material allegations of the complaint.
- (3) On August 21, 2013, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The parties explain that they have resolved all issues and request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (4) Being advised that the parties have resolved all issues raised by the complaint, the Commission finds that the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.
