On September 6, 2013, Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) submitted a Joint Stipulation and Recommendation setting forth the agreement of the signatory parties to resolve issues raised in the Notice of Intent that initiated the proceeding. Ohio Power Company was not a signatory to the agreement and was informed by counsel for the ODSA that the Examiner requested Ohio Power indicate its position on the stipulation in the docket by September 13, 2013.

Ohio Power's position on the agreement is that it has not signed, nor does it oppose the Joint Stipulation and Recommendation. This representation is being filed in the docket and served on all the parties as a record of the Ohio Power Company position for consideration by the Commission.
