ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 12, 2000, the Commission informed the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) and the Pooling Administrator (PA) of its intent to exercise jurisdiction over central office (NXX) code reclamation.¹ Pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) March 31, 2000, *Number Resource Optimization Order* in CC Docket 99-200, the Commission affirmatively accepted responsibility to investigate and reclaim NXX codes and thousands-blocks from Ohio carriers who had not activated the code(s) or thousands-block(s) within six months of its effective date.
- (2) On September 12, 2013, TSC Communications, Inc. (TSCC) filed a "Motion for Extension of Time in Which to Activate Telephone Numbering Resources." In its motion, TSCC explains that it is requesting an extension of time in which to activate the 567-250-5XXX block of the 567-250 code in the Findlay rate center. Absent Commission approval for an extension of time, the code will be subject to reclamation.
- (3) According to TSCC's motion, the company was unable to timely activate the numbering resources by the PA's activation deadline due to unanticipated delays in turning up the service while working with AT&T Ohio. TSCC is requesting a ninety-day extension in which to place the affected telephone numbering resources into service. TSCC further states that its request is appropriate given the short duration of the requested extension and the hardship imposed on the company of being forced to return the 567-250-5XXX thousand-block.

- (4) By entry issued on November 7, 2002, in Case 97-884-TP-COI, the Commission, on its own motion, delegated to its legal department the authority to rule, by attorney examiner's entry, on carrier numbering requests, other than those seeking reclamation of entire NXX codes or of particular one thousand number blocks.
- (5) After review of TSCC's motion, the attorney examiner believes that the applicant has demonstrated a legitimate need for a 90-day extension of time, until December 18, 2013, for the activation of the aforementioned numbering resources. Should TSCC be unable to activate the numbering resources by the new deadline, TSCC will need to provide detailed documentation as to the reasons for the additional delay.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That TSCC's motion is granted in accordance with Finding (5). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon TSCC.
