EXAMINER SEE: So you entered appearances for DP&L and FirstEnergy Companies?

MR. STINSON: Correct.

EXAMINER SEE: I note that Ohio Power is not present.

MR. STINSON: I've had conversations with Ohio Power and I haven't heard back from them.

I've had conversations with Duke, with Elizabeth Watts, who indicated she would not be attending today, but Duke did not oppose -- did not sign, but would not oppose the stipulation.

EXAMINER SEE: Did you have that same conversation with Ohio Power?

MR. STINSON: I haven't had that conversation with Ohio Power yet.

EXAMINER SEE: Okay. Let's proceed.

Mr. Stinson.

(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

MR. STINSON: Yes, your Honor. On Friday, we filed a Joint Stipulation. I've marked that as Joint Exhibit No. 1. I've given that to the court reporter. It's a stipulation signed by the majority of the parties in this proceeding and we would move its admission into the record.

EXAMINER SEE: Are there any objections to the --

MR. McNAMEE: Your Honor, not an objection, but a clarification. You'll notice, when you review that document, there is no -- the Staff has not -- excuse me -- has not signed it; that does not mean we oppose it. We do not oppose it.

As is customary in these cases, the Staff has reviewed the filings in the case for mathematical accuracy. Everything appears to be mathematically accurate. And so, we have no problem in the case, but we do not sign on to the stipulation, so.

EXAMINER SEE: Okay. For the parties, the other parties present, are there any objections to the admission of Joint Exhibit 1?

MR. SERIO: No objection, your Honor.

MS. MOONEY: No objection.

MR. ELISAR: No objections, your Honor.

EXAMINER SEE: Mr. Stinson, I note that Ohio Power nor Duke have signed on to the stipulation. If you are going to be discussing this with them, let -- I would like for you to contact them and file something in the record indicating whether or not they oppose or are not opposing the stipulation.

MR. STINSON: Duke has indicated that they are not signing, but they do not oppose the stipulation.

EXAMINER SEE: And I would request that you contact Ms. Watts and have her file a letter --

MR. McNAMEE: File a letter.

MR. STINSON: Pardon me?

EXAMINER SEE: And I would request that you contact Ms. Watts and have her file a letter in the docket, supporting that position, by the end of the week. Okay? And the same with counsel for Ohio Power.

MR. STINSON: Thank you, your Honor.

EXAMINER SEE: Mr. Serio --

MR. SERIO: Yes.

EXAMINER SEE: -- I note that you're not opposing.

MR. SERIO: That's correct, your Honor.

We did not sign; we're not opposing. That's why I came this morning to put that on the record for you.

EXAMINER SEE: Okay. Thank you very much.

EXAMINER SEE: With that, Joint Exhibit 1 is admitted into the record.

With respect to the application of -- or, the Notice of Intent that was filed May 31st, there is an Exhibit A that was also attached to the Notice of Intent, and on page 3, the first full paragraph, there was a typographical error in the last sentence.

The original read: "Thus in the 2013 USF rate case, the EPP allocations for Dayton Power and Light and American Electric Power increased to try to mitigate the increases in costs and the allocations decreased for Dayton Power and Light and American Electric Power due to their reduced costs."

Some of the names of the utilities are transposed there and the sentence should read as

follows: "Thus in the 2013 USF rate case, the EPP allocations for Dayton Power and Light and American Electric Power increased to try to mitigate the increases in costs and the allocations decreased for the FirstEnergy Companies and Duke Energy Ohio due to their reduced costs."

EXAMINER SEE: Okay. Thank you.

Is there anything else?

MR. STINSON: Nothing, your Honor.

EXAMINER SEE: Okay. That being the case, the hearing is adjourned. Thank you all very

much.
