



Other than its Ohio CRES certification as a Power Broker, Scioto Energy does not hold any licenses nor is certified/registered or otherwise authorized to provide retail or wholesale electric services including aggregations services in any other jurisdiction.

Scioto Energy is an independent brokerage and consulting firm founded in 2009 to provide energy solutions for clients in the areas of energy procurement, rate analysis, risk management and load response. The managing partners are seasoned energy professionals with over 30 years of experience in both energy trading and energy retail marketing. Scioto Energy is completely independent from any wholesale supplier; our only allegiance is to our customers.
