Effective October 30, 2013, XO will tariff a Service Extension Charge. This charge will be assessed when the customer requests, and XO agrees to provide, service to a location beyond XO's demarcation point. Services less than or equal to a DS1 (1.544 Mbps) will incur a non-recurring charge of \$325 for the first circuit and \$80 per additional circuit. Services equal to a DS3 (44.736 Mbps) will incur a non-recurring charge of \$550 per circuit.
