- (1) On September 26, 2013, the Ohio Central Railroad (OCR) filed a request to downgrade the warning devices at the Chestnut Street crossing (474-200T) located in the city of Coshocton. OCR states that the track structure running through the roadway is being removed in order to improve the road surface. OCR notes that there have been no train movements over the crossing for five years, and requests that the crossing be closed and all warning devices be removed.
- (2) In light of OCR's request, the attorney examiner finds that Staff should file a report of investigation on OCR's downgrade request. Accordingly, Staff should file its report of investigation on or before November 1, 2013.
- (3) Further, to assist the Commission in making its determination, the city of Coshocton and any other interested party should file comments in response to OCR's request by November 1, 2013.
