ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On August 22, 2013, Wendy Schlack (Complainant) initiated a complaint against TDS Telecom. In the complaint, Complainant claimed she was lied to and cheated and that she has certain telephone conversations on tape.
- (2) Rule 4901-9-01(B), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), directs, in part, that all complaints filed with the Commission are to be in writing, shall contain the name of the public utility complained against, must contain a statement which clearly explains the facts which constitute the basis of the complaint, and a statement of the relief sought.
- (3) By entry issued September 6, 2013, Complainant was given an opportunity to supplement the complaint with a clear explanation of the facts constituting the basis of the complaint as well as the relief being sought in accordance with Rule 4901-9-01(B), O.A.C. This supplement was due by October 4, 2013.
- (4) No supplement was filed by the October 4, 2013 deadline. At this time, the attorney examiner will afford the Complainant one last opportunity to supplement the complaint by providing a clear explanation of the facts constituting the basis of the complaint as well as the relief being sought in accordance with Rule 4901-9-01(B), O.A.C. Complainant should file such a supplement to the complaint by October 25, 2013, if she desires to pursue this matter. Failure to file a supplement to the

complaint by October 25, 2013, will result in a recommendation to the Commission that this matter be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute. Should Complainant supplement the complaint in this matter, TDS Telecom will have 20 days after service of the supplement by the Commission's docketing division to file an answer to the supplemented complaint.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties comply with finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
