ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On April 15, 2013, DP&L filed an application for approval of its energy efficiency and peak demand reduction program portfolio plan for 2013 through 2015 pursuant to Section 4928.66, Revised Code, Rules 4901:1-39-04, 4901:1-39-05, 4901:1-39-06, and 4901:1-39-07, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (3) On April 17, 2013, the attorney examiner established a procedural schedule pursuant to Chapter 4901:1-39, O.A.C., scheduling a deadline for intervention, deadline for filing objections, deadline for intervenor testimony, deadline for staff testimony, and hearing date. The attorney examiner scheduled the intervention deadline for June 18, 2013, and the hearing for September 26, 2013.
- (4) On June 14, 2013, and then again on July 17, August 7, and August 21, DP&L filed motions to modify the procedural schedule to extend the deadlines for filing objections and testimony. The attorney examiner granted each of the motions to extend the deadlines for filing objections and testimony.
- (5) On September 26, 2013, a hearing was held in this matter and this case was continued to permit the parties to engage in further settlement negotiations. No members of the public provided testimony at the hearing.

- (6) On October 2, 2013, a stipulation signed was filed in this case, signed by DP&L, Commission Staff, the Ohio Environmental Council, the Environmental Law and Policy Center, Ohio Partners for Affordable Energy, Ohio Advanced Energy Economy, Ohio Manufacturers Association Energy Group, Ohio Hospital Association, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, the Ohio Energy Group, Industrial Energy Users - Ohio, EMC Development Company, Inc., People Working Cooperatively, Inc., and EnerNoc, Inc. On October 9, 2013, the Sierra Club filed a notice that it does not oppose the stipulation.
- (7) The attorney examiner finds that this matter should be set for hearing. Accordingly, the hearing should be scheduled for October 22, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 11-A, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the hearing be scheduled in this case for October 22, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 11-A, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
