ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) The above-referenced complaint was filed on June 21, 2013. In the complaint, Jerry Jerome Dobish, a customer of The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), alleged that a neutral ground on CEI's power pole failed and caused an electrical surge that damaged property inside his residence.
- (2) On July 11, 2013, CEI filed an answer denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) On September 20, 2013, Mr. Dobish and CEI filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the parties state that they have agreed to a settlement of the matters in controversy in this case. The parties, therefore, request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (4) In view of the resolution of the complaint, this case should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the parties' joint motion to dismiss be granted and that this case be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


