A nonrecurring charge and a monthly charge apply for each point-to-point connection between the Telephone Company's ATM switch and the customer's ATM terminal equipment. The ATM OC3c and the OC12c Access Links are not available for meet point service arrangements. In this situation, the appropriate Optical Networking, OC3c and OC12c rate elements from the Optical Networking Access Services under Section 20 may be used, as applicable, in addition to the rate and charges associated with the ATM rate elements.
