ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), the Commission's Staff (Staff) served a notice of preliminary determination upon SEPI Services, Inc. (Respondent), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On July 23, 2013, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C. Thereafter, a prehearing conference was scheduled and held on September 16, 2013.
- (3) On October 3, 2013, Staff filed a motion to dismiss the case. In the motion to dismiss, Staff stated that, after a review of the facts and further investigation and discussion with the Ohio Highway Patrol, it determined that further prosecution of the alleged violation is not warranted and the violation should be deleted.
- (4) The Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss should be granted and this case should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 13-1674-TR-CVF be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the violation be removed from Respondent's history of violations. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.




