**APPLICATION OF THE DAYTON POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR APPROVAL
OF A REVISED BILL FORMAT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE**

1. Applicant the Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility and electric light company as defined by R.C. § 4905.02 and § 4905.03(A)(4) respectively, and an electric distribution utility as defined by R.C. § 4928.01(A)(6) and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the Commission).

2. Pursuant to O.A.C. § 4901:1-10-22(C), DP&L requests the Commission's approval of a change in bill format pursuant to the Order in Case No. 12-426-EL-SSO. DP&L hereby requests approval of the sample bill formats attached as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2.

3. DP&L's proposed bill format change is made in accordance with the Commission's Order filed on September 4, 2013 in Case No. 12-426-EL-SSO, and the amended Order filed on September 6, 2013. As contained in the Order, several existing charges will no longer be charged and several new charges will be introduced. The proposed bill formats in Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2 reflect the changes. The Order also states that the changes will be effective as of January 1, 2014.

4. The new 'Transmission Charge' will replace the existing 'Transmission Related Charges'. It will reflect the amount the utility charges to provide ancillary and market-based transmission service. DP&L's proposed bill format allows for an easier calculation of the price-


to-compare (PTC). The 'Transmission Charge' plus the 'Generation Charge' will equal the PTC. Also, the charge line 'Generation Rider' has been removed. The new 'Nonbypassable Charge' will be non-distribution related charges that are assessed to all customers.

5. The back of DP&L's bill, which displays DP&L's billing address and explanation of billing terms, includes necessary changes. Explanations of charges that will no longer be on the bill have been removed, and explanations of effective charges have been added. Finally, DP&L is proposing to make minor clarifications to existing explanations and some general clean-up items. The proposed changes to the back of DP&L's bill can be found in Exhibit 2.

CONCLUSION

DP&L respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Application for a new bill format.

EXPLANATION OF BILLING TERMS

ACTUAL READING

~~A reading Measured electricity taken from your meter.~~

CUSTOMER CHARGE

The fixed monthly basic distribution charge to partially cover costs for billing, meter reading, service line maintenance and equipment.

DISTRIBUTION CHARGE

~~Charge for moving electricity over electric distribution lines to your home or business.~~ Charges to recover various costs associated with electric operations, equipment, and Ohio energy-related programs.

**TRANSMISSION
RELATED CHARGES**

~~The amount the utility or a supplier charges for operating and maintaining the electric transmission system.~~

ESTIMATED READING

(EST or E) On the months we do not read your meter, we calculate your bill based on your past usage. Adjustments may be needed later when we take an actual meter reading. If you would like to read your own meter to avoid estimated bills, call the account information number on the front of the bill with your meter reading.

GENERATION CHARGE

Charge associated with the production of electricity. ~~Only customers who purchase generation service from DP&L pay this charge.~~

GENERATION RIDER

~~Charge associated with the production of electricity. All customers pay this charge, regardless of whether generation service is purchased from DP&L or another provider.~~

KILOWATT-HOUR (KWH)

The unit measure for electricity. For example, you use one kilowatt-hour of electricity to light a 100-watt bulb for 10 hours.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

A 1 1/2% late charge added to the overdue amount if you do not pay your bill by the due date for prompt payment.

NONBYPASSABLE CHARGE

Charges that are assessed to all customers.

PIPP PLUS

Percentage of Income Payment Plan

TRANSMISSION CHARGE

The amount the utility or supplier charges to provide ancillary and market-based transmission services.
