ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 23, 2013, Eastern Natural Gas Company, Pike Natural Gas Company, and Southeastern Natural Gas Company (collectively, the Companies) filed an application for approval of a revised bill format, in accordance with Rule 4901:1-13-11(D), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) Rule 4901:1-13-11(D), O.A.C., provides that, if the Commission does not act upon an application for a new bill format within 45 days, the proposed bill format shall be automatically approved. The 45-day time period for this application ends November 7, 2013.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional time is necessary in order to complete a review of this application. Therefore, these cases should be suspended from the automatic approval process, in order for the Commission and Staff to review the application further.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the application filed by the Companies be suspended from the automatic approval process in accordance with finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
