The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 22, 2013, Wendy Schlack (Complainant) filed a one-page complaint against TDS Telecom. In the complaint, Complainant claimed she was lied to and cheated and that she has certain telephone conversations on tape.
- (2) Noting the lack of a statement clearly explaining the facts which constitute the basis of the complaint and a statement of the relief being sought in accordance with Rule 4901-9-01(B), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), the attorney examiner, by entries issued September 6, 2013, and October 10, 2013, afforded the Complainant an opportunity to supplement the complaint. The October 10, 2013 entry also advised the Complainant that the failure to supplement this matter would result in a recommendation that this complaint be dismissed for failure to prosecute this matter.
- (3) To date, the Complainant has not filed the necessary supplement to the complaint as set forth in the September 6, 2013 and October 10, 2013 entries. Accordingly, the Commission finds that this complaint should be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this matter be dismissed in accordance with finding (3). It is, further,
