ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) A prehearing conference was held in this case on November 7, 2013. At the prehearing conference, the parties established a hearing date of January 23, 2014.
- (2) Accordingly, this case should be scheduled for hearing on January 23, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., in the offices of the Commission, in Hearing Room 11-C, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (3) Rule 4901:2-7-14(E), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to appear for the hearing shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability for the forfeiture proposed in the notice of preliminary determination.
- (4) At the hearing, following the presentation of evidence by Staff, it shall be the responsibility of the respondent, Eulalio Vera, to present evidence in support of his contentions regarding the alleged violation in this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 13-1999-TR-CVF be scheduled for hearing in accordance with Finding (2). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
