This is the continuation of Case No. 5 13-1406-EL-RDR being in the Matter of the Application 6 7 of Ohio Power Company to update its Transmission Cost Recovery Rider rates. 8 9 My name is Sarah Parrot and I'm the 10 Attorney Examiner assigned by the Commission to hear this case. 11 12 Let's get started with appearances and we 13 will start with Ohio Power Company. MR. ALAMI: Thank you, your Honor. On 14 behalf of the Ohio Power Company, Steven Nourse, 15 16 Matthew Satterwhite, Yazen Alami, One Riverside Plaza, 17 29th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. 18 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, Mr. Alami. And let's just work our way around the table. 19 20 MS. KYLER COHN: Good morning, Your Honor. On behalf of the Ohio Energy Group, Michael Kurtz and 21 22 Jody Kyler Cohn from the firm of Boehm, Kurtz & Lowry, 36 East 7th Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45236. 23 24 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you. MR. PRITCHARD: I'm Matthew Pritchard on 25

5	MR. BERGER: Your Honor, good morning.

8	Ohio 43215.
9	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you. Staff?
10	MR. O'ROURKE: Thank you, your Honor. Ryan
11	O'Rourke and with me is Tom Lindgren. We're with the
12	Ohio Attorney General's Office, Public Utilities
13	Section representing Staff today. Our address is 180
14	East Broad, 6th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
15	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, everyone.
16	And it's my understanding that a stipulation and
17	recommendation was filed in this case on November 8th
18	for the Commission's consideration. Mr. Alami?
19	MR. ALAMI: That's correct, your Honor.
20	And, your Honor, the parties have discussed earlier
21	that we would just we have several exhibits and as
22	part of the stipulation, the parties have agreed to the
23	admission of those exhibits without cross-examination.
24	The exhibits that we'll be moving for admission are
25	outlined in the stipulation and if your Honor would be

6 okay, we would just proceed with moving those exhibits 1 2 into the record at this time. 3 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Okay. Please proceed. 4 MR. ALAMI: Thank you, your Honor. The 5 company would mark as AEP Ohio Exhibit 1, the application filed on June 17th, 2013. 6 7 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So marked. MR. ALAMI: As AEP Ohio Exhibit No. 2, AEP 8 9 Ohio's reply comments filed on August 13, 2013. ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So marked. 10 MR. ALAMI: As AEP Ohio Exhibit No. 3, the 11 12 direct testimony of Andrea E. Moore filed on October 13 8th, 2013. As AEP Ohio Exhibit No. 4, the direct testimony of Eric J. Gleckler filed on October 8th, 14 2013. And as AEP Ohio Exhibit No 5, testimony of 15 16 Andrea E. Moore in support of the stipulation and recommendation filed on November 8th -- excuse me, 17 18 filed on November 12th, 2013. ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Those exhibits are so 19 20 marked. MR. ALAMI: Thank you, your Honor. We 21 22 would also ask that we mark as Joint Exhibit 1 the 23 joint stipulation and recommendation filed on November 8th, 2013. 24 25 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. So marked.

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1	MR. ALAMI: And we ask that those exhibits
2	be admitted into the record as there's been an
3	indication there would be no cross.
4	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. Are there
5	any objections to the admission of AEP Exhibits 1
6	through 5 or Joint Exhibit 1? Seeing none,
7	AEP Exhibits 1 through 5 and Joint Exhibit 1 are
8	admitted into the record.
9	Do other parties have documents that they
10	wish to
11	MR. PRITCHARD: Yes, your Honor.
12	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. Very good.
13	Thank you, Mr. Pritchard.
14	MR. PRITCHARD: Good morning, your Honor.
15	While IEU Ohio is not a signatory party to this
16	stipulation, the stipulation recommended that all of
17	the comments and testimony be moved into the record.
18	IEU Ohio had filed comments, so I would like to mark
19	IEU Ohio's comments filed on July 29, 2013, as IEU Ohio
20	Exhibit 1.
21	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So marked.
22	MR. PRITCHARD: And just a brief statement
23	for the record. IEU Ohio participated in the
24	settlement discussions and while IEU Ohio does not
25	oppose the outcome of this case, which recognize the

reduction and the revenue requirement requested in AEP 1 2 Ohio's application, IEU Ohio did not agree to all the 3 language of the stipulation, but we don't oppose the 4 outcome and we won't have any cross-examination today. 5 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you for that clarification. Are there any objections to the 6 7 admission of IEU Exhibit 1? Seeing none, it shall be admitted. Mr. Berger? 8 9 Thank you, you Honor. The MR. BERGER: Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel has three 10 exhibits we would like to mark for the record. The 11 12 first is OCC's comments filed on July 29th, 2013. We'd like to mark that as OCC Exhibit 1. 13 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So marked. 14 MR. BERGER: The direct testimony of Beth 15 16 E. Hixon we would like to mark as OCC Exhibit No. 2. 17 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So marked. 18 MR. BERGER: And the direct testimony of 19 Sari Fink in support of the stipulation, which was 20 filed yesterday, we'd like to mark it as OCC Exhibit No. 3. 21 22 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: So marked. MR. BERGER: I'm providing the court 23 24 reporter with copies of those at this time. Do you 25 need a copy of those?

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9 1 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: No, thank you. 2 MR. BERGER: Your Honor, I believe all 3 parties have waived cross-examination and by 4 stipulation we would move for the admission of these 5 exhibits into the record. ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. Are there 6 7 any objections? Seeing none, OCC Exhibits 1 through 3 8 are admitted. 9 MR. BERGER: Thank you. 10 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, Mr. Berger. Staff? 11 12 MR. O'ROURKE: Thank you, your Honor. Staff has three exhibits that it would like to have 13 14 marked. First, Staff Exhibit 1 are the comments filed by Staff on August 13th, 2013. The second would be 15 16 Staff Exhibit 2, and this is the testimony of Jeffrey 17 Hecker. And the third Staff exhibit would be the 18 testimony of Dave Lipthratt in support of the 19 stipulation. 20 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: The exhibits are so 21 marked. 22 MR. O'ROURKE: And we have copies for the 23 court reporter. 24 MR. BERGER: Ryan, the comments of Staff, 25 is that the review and recommendations?

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1	MR. O'ROURKE: Yes.
2	It's my understanding, your Honor, there's
3	no cross-examination on any of the exhibits so we would
4	seek to have them moved into the record.
5	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Are there any
6	objections to the admission of Staff Exhibits 1 through
7	3? Seeing none, those exhibits are also admitted into
8	the record.
9	MR. PRITCHARD: Your Honor, while I was
10	presenting my exhibits I didn't ask for their
11	admission. I'm not sure if you had noted that IEU Ohio
12	Exhibit 1 had been admitted or not.
13	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: I believe we did. I
14	believe you've done so, but just in case, as a
15	precautionary measure, IEU Exhibit 1 is admitted into
16	the record, Mr. Pritchard.
17	MR. PRITCHARD: Thank you, your Honor.
18	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Is there anything else
19	to come before us today? All right. Seeing nothing
20	then, we are adjourned and I thank you all for your
21	hard work on the stipulation.
