ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Commission Staff (Staff) served a notice of preliminary determination upon Millis Transfer, Inc. (respondent), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On October 7, 2013, respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) By entry dated October 16, 2013, a prehearing conference was scheduled for November 22, 2013.
- (4) On November 21, 2013, Staff filed a letter stating that the parties have reached an agreement in principle, making the November 22, 2013, prehearing conference unnecessary. In the event that a settlement agreement is not filed in the docket as planned, Staff requests that the prehearing conference be rescheduled for a later date.
- (5) The attorney examiner finds that Staff's request for a continuance is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the prehearing conference, if necessary, should be continued to a date to be established by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the prehearing conference scheduled for November 22, 2013, be continued to a date to be established by subsequent entry. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
