ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) This civil forfeiture case was filed on July 22, 2013, by Scott P. Damron (respondent). Thereafter, a prehearing conference was held and a hearing was scheduled in the matter. The hearing was held in this matter on November 5, 2013.
- (2) On November 15, 2013, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a motion to dismiss the case. In the motion to dismiss, Staff stated that, after a review of the facts, further prosecution of the alleged violation is not warranted and that the violation should be deleted. Accordingly, Staff requested that the Commission dismiss the case and close the record.
- (3) The Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss this case is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Case No. 13-1666-TR-CVF be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.




