LIST OF ISSUES OF KENT F. HAMPTON AND MARILYN TREMAIN HAMPTON

Pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's Entry of October 30, 2013, Kent F. Hampton and Marilyn Tremain Hampton submit the following list of issues citing specific concerns about which they may be interested in pursuing cross-examination of witnesses at the evidentiary hearing of these consolidated matters:

1. The preferred interconnect substation is directly across the roadway from the Hamptons' 120-year old farm house. The substation and the preferred transmission route leading to the substation will be a significant change to the bucolic nature of the farm. The Hamptons object to the location of the preferred interconnect substation and request that the alternate interconnect substation and alternate transmission route be selected. In the alternative, the Hamptons' request that the Applicant construct a berm along the roadway edge of the preferred interconnection substation parcel that is high and wide enough to block the view of the substation from the Hamptons' farmhouse and the adjoining yards. The Hamptons ask that two rows of an assortment of evergreen trees be planted on this berm. These trees should be spaced every 10 feet in alternate rows to provide dense screening. The trees should be a minimum of 5-6 feet high at planting. The Applicant should be required to maintain the berm and to be responsible for replacement of trees that die for the life of its

project. The Hamptons also request that the substation not be lighted at night, except as needed for emergencies.

- 2. The Hamptons object to the Applicant locating any wind turbines and associated power lines, buried and overhead, on the Hamptons' property in any way.
- 3. The Hamptons object to the Applicant's proposed wind turbine that is currently planned to be constructed next to the fence row between the Febiger property and the Hamptons' property. This turbine site does not meet the setback requirement of 541 feet from a non-participating property line.
