NOTICE TO TAKE DEPOSITIONS AND REQUESTS FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS BY THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO CONSUMERS' COUNSEL

Pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code Section 4901-1-21(B), please take notice that the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC") will take the deposition upon oral examination of the following:

- (1) All persons who will be called by the Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L") to present testimony, including direct, supplemental, rebuttal, surrebuttal, and any other form of testimony filed, or to be filed in these proceedings; and
- (2) All persons responsible for answering OCC's interrogatories and/or responding to requests for production of documents (including responses that state that no documents are responsive to a request to produce) served in these proceedings upon DP&L; and
- (3) Person(s) with knowledge of insurance policies that cover claims associated with DP&L storm damage in 2008, 2011 and/or 2012; and
- (4) Person(s) with knowledge of storm reserve accounts in regard to DP&L storm damage in 2008, 2011 and/or 2012; and
- (5) Person(s) with knowledge of mutual assistance agreements applicable to DP&L in 2008, 2011 and 2012.

OCC seeks to conduct the depositions upon oral examination at OCC's offices, 10 W. Broad St., 18th Floor, Columbus, Ohio, at 10:00 a.m. beginning on January 30, 2014, or such other time that is mutually agreed upon by the Parties. The depositions will continue, one-after-the-other, from day to day, except for holidays and weekends, until completed. The depositions will be taken of the aforementioned deponents on relevant topics within the scope of this proceeding, including but not limited to, the subject matter of the deponent's testimony and the deponent's knowledge and expertise with the subject matter of this proceeding. These depositions will be taken upon oral examination (as upon cross-examination) before an officer authorized by law to take depositions.

- 5. All insurance policies that cover claims associated with DP&L storm damage in 2008, 2011 and/or 2012.
