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4 EXAMINER JENNINGS: We are here for the
5 workshop scheduled for today in Case No.
6 13-2317-TR-ORD being captioned in the Matter of the
7 Commission's Review of Chapter 4901:2-1 Regarding
8 Motor Carrier Tax Payments and Annual Reports and
9 Chapter 4901:2-13 Regarding Motor Carrier Insurance.

10 My name is Doug Jennings. I am an
11 Attorney Examiner assigned by the Commission for this
12 case.

13 Before I get started I would like to give
14 a brief overview of why this workshop has been
15 scheduled. The workshop is being held in response to
16 the issuance of the Governor's Common Sense
17 Initiative as well as Section 121.82 of the Revised
18 Code which requires the Commission to evaluate its
19 rules against business impact analysis and provide
20 that analysis to the Common Sense Initiative Office.

21 In incorporating the Common Sense
22 Initiative into our rule review process the
23 Commission has determined that it is appropriate for
24 its staff to hold a workshop with interested
25 stakeholders. The purpose of this workshop is to get

1 input regarding the rules addressing the motor
2 carrier tax payments and annual reports and also
3 motor carrier insurance rules.

4 I want to emphasize that this is only
5 parties' initial opportunity to provide feedback on
6 the current state of the rules. The Commission will
7 issue a proposed set of rules at some point following
8 this workshop and will utilize the same comment and
9 reply comment process that is typically established.

10 At that point stakeholders will have the
11 opportunity to formally offer any recommendation and
12 file comments, reply comments. Today's workshop is
13 intended to seek initial thoughts and any
14 recommendations on how the rules could be improved.

15 I will reiterate that Commission entry
16 issuing proposed rules for comment will be following
17 in the near future.

18 I will note for the record that no
19 stakeholders have appeared for the workshop. And
20 that being the case, I will adjourn this matter, and
21 the stakeholders will have an opportunity to file
22 comments in response to proposed rules.
