My name is Doug Jennings. I am an Attorney Examiner assigned by the Commission for this case.

Before I get started I would like to give a brief overview of why this workshop has been scheduled. The workshop is being held in response to the issuance of the Governor's Common Sense Initiative as well as Section 121.82 of the Revised Code which requires the Commission to evaluate its rules against business impact analysis and provide that analysis to the Common Sense Initiative Office.

In incorporating the Common Sense

Initiative into our rule review process the

Commission has determined that it is appropriate for its staff to hold a workshop with interested stakeholders. The purpose of this workshop is to get

input regarding the rules addressing the motor carrier tax payments and annual reports and also motor carrier insurance rules.

The Commission will issue a proposed set of rules at some point following this workshop and will utilize the same comment and reply comment process that is typically established.

At that point stakeholders will have the opportunity to formally offer any recommendation and file comments, reply comments. Today's workshop is intended to seek initial thoughts and any recommendations on how the rules could be improved.

I will reiterate that Commission entry issuing proposed rules for comment will be following in the near future.

I will note for the record that no stakeholders have appeared for the workshop. And that being the case, I will adjourn this matter, and the stakeholders will have an opportunity to file comments in response to proposed rules.
