ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Case No. 12-3119-EL-CSS (12-3119) and Case No. 13-531-GE-CSS (13-531) were filed on November 30, 2012, and February 28, 2013, respectively. In the complaints, Shirley Bailey, the complainant in 12-3119, and Leap of Faith Life Ministries, Inc. (Leap of Faith), the complainant in 13-531, alleged unjust and unfair billing practices by Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke or company).
- (2) Duke filed answers denying the allegations in 12-3119 on December 19, 2012, and in 13-531 on March 13 and April 10, 2013.
- (3) The initial settlement conference and hearing were scheduled for February 5, 2013, and June 26, 2013, respectively, in 12-3119. After

several continuances, the hearing for both cases was rescheduled for January 22, 2014.

- (4) On January 17, 2014, Ms. Bailey, Leap of Faith, and Duke filed joint motions to dismiss the complaints. In the motions, the parties state that they have settled these matters and all issues raised in the complaints have been resolved. The parties, therefore, request that the complaints be dismissed with prejudice.
- (5) The Commission finds that, in view of the resolution of the complaints, these cases should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' joint motions to dismiss be granted and that these cases be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
