MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

A renewal application for natural gas governmental aggregation was emailed to the Village of Warsaw in November, 2013. The office clerk who received such email subsequently left the Village's employ, leaving the Mayor and Council Members unaware of the renewal application deadline. Upon learning of this issue, an emergency vote to approve the Authorizing Ordinance was scheduled for Monday, February 24, 2014. At the conclusion of the scheduled hearing, it is anticipated that Warsaw will have approved the Ordinance and be able to submit the renewal application within the deadline requested herein. The certificate expires on March 14, 2014. This will not provide the PUCO with the requisite 30 days to review the renewal application before the expiration date. Warsaw requests that its current certification be extended until April 4, 2014.

Warsaw maintains that this extension will not prejudice any party.

Wherefore, Village of Warsaw respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion for Extension of Certification Expiration Date.
