
REPLY COMMENTS OF DUKE ENERGY OHIO, INC.

The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) filed an application initiating this proceeding on December 20, 2013. By Entry issued January 3, 2014, the Attorney Examiner invited interested parties to file comments regarding the content of DP&L's application for authority to transfer, sell, or decommission some or all of its generation assets and waivers from certain filing requirements. The Entry directed the parties to file comments on February 4, 2014, and reply comments on February 19, 2014. Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy Ohio) timely filed for intervention and filed its comments. Below are the reply comments of Duke Energy Ohio.

Duke Energy Ohio is in agreement with the majority of the interested parties in that it is difficult to make substantive comments at this time, given the lack of information provided in DP&L's application. Accordingly, Duke Energy Ohio requests the opportunity to file additional comments when DP&L files a complete application and detailed plan to sell or transfer its generation assets. Additionally, absent a substantive application, DP&L's requests for various waivers are premature and do not provide this Commission with sufficient information to grant its requests. Duke Energy Ohio recommends that the Commission consider DP&L's requests for various waivers at a later time, when the company files a more comprehensive plan.
