- 6. Recommended Condition 5 relating to the level of detail required in facility layout drawings.

- 7. Recommended Condition 6 prohibiting any construction until CCE has signed an Interconnection Service Agreement with PJM.
- 8. Recommended Condition 7 relating to the timing of the submittal of the final landscape and lighting plan for the facility.
- 9. Recommended Condition 8 relating to coordination with local officials and the final traffic plan.
 - 10. Recommended Condition 9 relating to construction hours.
 - 11. Recommended Condition 10 relating to coal seam and mine void determination.
- 12. Recommended Condition 11 relating to the timing for Staff's review of a blasting plan.
- 13. Recommended Condition 12 relating to financial assurance and the parties to a Road Use Agreement.
- 14. Recommended Condition 14 (mislabeled as Condition 15 in the Staff Report of Investigation) relating to public and private airport notification.

The Applicant reserves the right to cross-examine any witness of an intervening party on any issue raised in that witness' direct testimony; cross examination or rebuttal testimony, and to

raise additional issues at hearing based on direct testimony and issues raised during crossexamination.
