The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 20, 2013, the Safe Harbor Water Power Corporation (Safe Harbor) filed an application for certification of its hydroelectric generation facility located on the Susquehanna River in Conestoga, Pennsylvania, as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), the application was automatically approved on the 61st day after the application was filed, and Certificate No. 13-HYD-PA-GATS-0402 was issued to the facility with an effective date of May 20, 2013.
- (3) On February 12, 2014, Safe Harbor filed responses to Staff interrogatories regarding work done on the facility and its operations.
- (4) On March 3, 2014, Staff issued its review and recommendation that the certification of this facility be revoked as the facility fails to qualify under the statutory placed-in-service date requirements of R.C. 4928.64(A)(1).
- (5) Safe Harbor and interested persons should be granted until March 14, 2014, to file any comments relating to Staff's recommendations in this case.

It is, therefore,
