10	My name is Scott Farkas. I am the	
11	Attorney Examiner assigned to hear this case. At

14	MR. YURICK: On behalf of the company,

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record there were no intervenors in this case and 1 2 that the company according to the docket card in the 3 case filed proof of publication of the notice of hearing and that there are no members of the public 4 5 present in the hearing room. It's also my understanding that the 6 7 parties have entered into a stipulation; is that 8 correct? 9 MR. YURICK: That's correct, your Honor. 10 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. And the 11 stipulation -- and that's correct also from the 12 staff? 13 MR. PARRAM: Yes, your Honor. 14 EXAMINER FARKAS: And the stipulation 15 resolved all the issues that were at -- involved in 16 the case? 17 MR. YURICK: Yes, that's correct, your 18 Honor. 19 MR. PARRAM: Yes, your Honor. 20 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. And I believe 21 staff has a witness in support of the stipulation? 22 MR. PARRAM: Yes, your Honor. Staff would like to call Staff Witness Patrick Donlon to 23 24 the stand. 25 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay.

6 1 PATRICK DONLON 2 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was examined and testified as follows: 3 4 DIRECT EXAMINATION 5 By Mr. Parram: Will you please state your name and 6 Ο. 7 business address for the record. 8 Patrick Donlon, 180 East Broad, Columbus, Α. Ohio 43215. 9 10 Ο. Who are you currently employed by? The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. 11 Α. 12 And what is your position at the PUCO? Ο. Utilities administrator. 13 Α. 14 MR. PARRAM: Your Honor, I would like to 15 have marked for purposes of identification Joint 16 Exhibit 1 which is the stipulation and recommendation 17 that has been filed in this case. 18 EXAMINER FARKAS: So marked. 19 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) 20 MR. PARRAM: May I approach, your Honor? 21 EXAMINER FARKAS: Yes. 22 Mr. Donlon, I've handed you an exhibit Q. 23 marked Joint Exhibit 1. Are you familiar with this 24 document? 25 A. Yes, I am.

7 1 What is this document? Ο. 2 Α. It's the stipulation for the GCR of 3 Brainard between the staff and Brainard. 4 Ο. And could you please summarize the major 5 points of the stipulation. The stipulation is basically taking the 6 Α. recommendations of the Staff Report and just 7 8 clarifying some of the steps the company will take to 9 ensure that those recommendations are met. 10 Ο. And in your opinion does the stipulation 11 represent the product of serious bargaining among 12 capable and knowledgeable parties? 13 Α. Yes, it does. 14 And does the stipulation benefit the Ο. customers and the public interest? 15 16 Yes, it does. Α. 17 And does the stipulation violate any Ο. important regulatory practice or principle? 18 19 Α. No. 20 And does the stipulation resolve all of Ο. 21 the issues in this case? 22 Α. Yes. 23 MR. PARRAM: That's all I have, your 24 No further questions for Mr. Donlon. Honor. 25 EXAMINER FARKAS: Do you have any

8 questions? 1 2 MR. YURICK: No questions on behalf of 3 the company. 4 EXAMINER FARKAS: Does the staff plan on 5 entering the Staff Report as an exhibit? MR. PARRAM: Yes. I was going to do that 6 7 afterwards. 8 EXAMINER FARKAS: Perfect. Okay. I have 9 no questions. You're excused. 10 THE WITNESS: Thank you. MR. YURICK: No, your Honor.

EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. That will also be admitted. That was Joint Exhibit 1. (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) MR. PARRAM: Thank you, your Honor. That's all we have. EXAMINER FARKAS: Anything further from the company? MR. YURICK: Nothing on behalf of the company. Thank you, your Honor. EXAMINER FARKAS: I believe that's all. We'll submit this on the record and appreciate everyone being here. Thank you. (Thereupon, the hearing was concluded at 10:07 a.m.)
