## FINDING AND ORDER

## The Commission finds:

- (1) Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia), is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- (2) On October 11, 2013, Columbia filed an application, pursuant to R.C. 4909.18, for authority to revise its tariffs to allow for the resale of natural gas at compressed natural gas fueling stations. Columbia explains that it is necessary to change its tariff to fully support the development of the natural gas vehicle market and provide natural gas to compressed natural gas fueling stations that serve the public. In addition, Columbia states that the tariff revision will support the natural gas vehicle market and Ohio's economic development efforts.
- (3) On February 20, 2014, Honda of America Mfg., Inc., filed a letter in support of Columbia's application for revision of the tariff to allow for the resale of natural gas at compressed natural gas fueling stations and increase the transportation options available to the citizens of Ohio.
- (4) The Commission has reviewed the application filed on October 11, 2013, and finds that it is reasonable and should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Columbia's application filed on October 11, 2013, is approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Columbia is authorized to file, in final form, four, complete copies of its tariffs consistent with this Finding and Order. Columbia shall file one copy in its tariff (TRF) docket and one copy in this docket. The remaining two copies

shall be designated for distribution to the Rates Division, of the Commission's Utilities Department. The effective date of the tariffs shall be a date not earlier than the date upon which complete, copies of the final tariff pages are filed with the Commission. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon Columbia and all interested persons of record in this case.
