The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) A prehearing conference was held in this case on March 20, 2014. At the prehearing conference, the parties established a hearing date of May 8, 2014.
- (2) Accordingly, this case should be scheduled for hearing on May 8, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., in the offices of the Commission, in Hearing Room 11-C, 11th floor, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (3) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E) provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to appear for the hearing shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability for the forfeiture proposed in the notice of preliminary determination.
- (4) At the hearing, following the presentation of evidence by Staff, it shall be the responsibility of the Respondents, Auto Plaza, Inc. and Dennis E. Hardesty, to present evidence in support of their contentions regarding the alleged violations in this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 14-119-TR-CVF be scheduled for hearing in accordance with Finding (2). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
