Thank you for contacting the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) regarding American Electric Power Transmission Company's (AEP Transco) proposed Biers Run – Hopetown – Delano 138 kV Transmission Line Project. Your correspondence in regards to the project has been docketed in case number 13-0429-EL-BTX.

The Ohio Power Siting Board has jurisdiction over electric transmission lines greater than 125 kilovolts (kV). Thus, the OPSB has jurisdiction over the Biers Run – Hopetown – Delano project but the 68 kV line mentioned in your letter would not fall under the OPSB's purview.

It is noted that you support the Alternate Route of the proposed Biers Run – Hopetown – Delano transmission line.

A local public hearing will be held in the case at a date scheduled by the Administrative Law Judge. Information about this hearing will be published by the Applicant and available on the OPSB website at [www.opsb.ohio.gov](http://www.opsb.ohio.gov). The OPSB website also hosts an interactive map developed with data from the application that portrays the proposed Preferred and Alternate routes.

We would like to voice our opposition to the American Electrical Power's Plan to construct a 138 KV transmission line and accompanied 69 KV line, adjacent to my rear residence property line. This line also crosses through the middle of our adjacent property, which is the entry of Golf View.

I understand, through AEP'S website, and favor the alternate route north, or even the previous southern route along the south edge of Golf View. I would like the opportunity to testify at any future public hearing on this project.

I fill AEP is a Utility Bully by the way they communicated with us. They came to my door demanding I sign a form allowing them to survey. I did not sign form giving them permission on my property. AEP has never communicated their intended routes, only that they had the right to go where they pleased to survey.

Our neighborhood is powered by South Central Power. This project does not in any shape or form profit us. This line would impact our properties, our property values, and our health.
