EXHIBIT A

DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARY CHANGE

This application is filed pursuant to section 4901:1-6-32 of the Commission's rules. United Telephone Company of Ohio proposes to change the boundary between two of its adjacent exchanges, Pataskala and Alexandria. No other ILECs are involved in this proposed change. The boundary change is focused on the Stonesthrow Estates housing development and would extend the Alexandria exchange boundary to the western and southern borders of this development. Currently, these customers are served on Pataskala service loops that exceed 20,000 cable feet resulting in slower than desired broadband internet speed offerings. Upgrading these existing Pataskala cable facilities would be costly and time consuming. This proposed boundary change would enable the Company to serve these customers from existing Alexandria facilities that are already equipped to offer higher broadband internet speeds.

A phone number change will be required for those affected by the boundary change. All customers except one have signed a petition requesting the boundary change and consenting to a change in telephone number. The one remaining customer's voice and data services will remain unchanged as part of this boundary change. The customers that live on Paradise Valley Drive, Paradise Valley Court, and Stonesthrow Drive will be impacted.

Exhibit A-1 provides a more complete depiction of the proposed boundary change. The Company will work with Staff to ensure the Commission's maps accurately reflect this boundary change. The public interest and demand for high broadband internet speeds would be served by the proposed change and consent of the change from the interested group has been obtained.

Proposed Change to the Pataskala/Alexandria Telephone Exchange Boundary






EXHIBIT B REASONS FOR MAKING THE CHANGE AND THE EFFECT OF THE CHANGE

The Stonesthrow Estates Owners Association (SEOA) approached United Telephone Company of Ohio d/b/a CenturyLink to obtain higher broadband internet speed for its members' homes. Upgrading existing Pataskala cable facilities would be costly and time consuming. The proposed boundary change will permit the Company to utilize existing Alexandria cable facilities to offer the same voice services while increasing the broadband internet speeds to this customer base.

The proposed boundary change will result in a telephone number change for the existing customers from the Pataskala 740-927-xxxx number pool to the Alexandria 740-924-xxxx telephone numbers. The EAS calling scope will change as well for the impacted customers. A signed petition was presented to CenturyLink by the homeowners consenting to the boundary change with the goal of improving the performance of Internet connections within Stonesthrow Estates. Only one customer objected to the change. The Company will allow that customer to retain his existing Pataskala service. Once the boundary change is completed, these impacted customers will be able to upgrade their internet speed offerings and have a voice service as well.
