ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Borys Melnyk, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations, specifically 49 C.F.R. 383.51.
- (2) On January 28, 2014 Borys Melnyk requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm. Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) On February 27, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an entry directing the parties to participate in a prehearing conference on March 14, 2014.
- (4) March 21, 2014, Staff filed a motion to dismiss the matter. Staff states that after a review of the facts of the case, and further investigation and discussion with the Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSP), Staff and OSP agree that further prosecution of the alleged violation of 49 C.F.R. 383.51 is not warranted, and the violation should be deleted. Staff requests that the Commission dismiss the case.
- (5) The Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss the matter and delete the violation is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Staff's motion to dismiss the matter and delete the violation is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
