> Re: Motion for Certain Waivers, Case No. 14-0469-EL-BTX

Dear Honorable Mandy Willey Chiles:

On March 27, 2014, the Dayton Power & Light Company (DP&L or Applicant) filed a motion for certain waivers. In the motion, Applicant requested the following waivers on an expedited basis:

- (1) From the requirement that the alternate route shall not have more than 20% in common with the preferred route as set forth in O.A.C. 4906-5-04(A), and instead allow for the alternate route to have 30% in common with the preferred route; and
- (2) From the requirement that all certificate applications for electric transmission facilities shall include fully developed information on two routes in as set forth in O.A.C. 4906-5-04(A), and instead permit Applicant to report results of field studies and investigations for ecological and cultural resources for only the preferred route.

The Staff of the Ohio Power Siting Board (Staff) does not object to the requested waivers, but reserves the right to require information from the Applicant in areas covered by the requested waiver if Staff determines it to be necessary during the course of the investigation. The Staff also reserves the right to investigate and contest all other issues presented in the application.
