Dear Ms. McNeal:

On March 17, 2014, Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") issued an Opinion, Order and Certificate issuing Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. ("Vectren") a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need subject to a number of conditions.

Condition No. 17 of the Order requires the following:

Vectren shall have a Staff-approved environmental specialist on site during construction activities that may affect sensitive areas, as mutually agreed upon between the Applicant and Staff, and as shown on the Applicant's final approved construction plan. Sensitive areas include, but are not limited to, areas of vegetation clearing, designated wetlands and streams, and locations of threatened or endangered species or their identified habitat. The environmental specialist shall be familiar with water quality protection issues and potential threatened or endangered species of plants and animals that may be encountered during project construction.

In compliance with Condition No. 17 of the Board's Order, attached for Staff approval is a copy of the qualifications of Ms. Stahl as the onsite environmental specialist selected by Vectren.

We request that the Staff notify Applicant about the acceptability of Ms. Stahl as the environmental specialist.


