<u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined by R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On December 21, 2012, DP&L filed an application seeking authority to recover storm Operation and Maintenance (O&M) expenses for all major event storms in 2011 and 2012, as well as certain 2008 storm O&M expenses. DP&L also requests authority to implement a storm cost recovery rider to recover all costs associated with major storms going forward and to defer O&M costs until they are recovered through the rider.
- (3) By Entry issued on October 23, 2013, the attorney examiner adopted a procedural schedule in this matter. Subsequently, on December 18, 2013, the Commission issued an Entry on Rehearing with a modified procedural schedule. Following the Commission's Entry on Rehearing, on February 6, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an Entry granting an unopposed motion filed by DP&L to continue the evidentiary hearing. Subsequently, by Entry issued on March 7, 2014, the attorney examiner granted a second unopposed motion by DP&L to continue the evidentiary hearing.

(4) On April 15, 2014, the attorney examiner was notified by the parties to this proceeding that additional time may be necessary for further settlement negotiations. Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that the procedural schedule in this case should be suspended. The attorney examiner will schedule the evidentiary hearing by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the procedural schedule in this case be suspended and the evidentiary hearing set by subsequent entry. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
