Dear Mr. Fosson,

Thank you for your comments related to Everpower's Buckeye Wind I and II projects. Several of the comments stand out and are worth responding to.

The Board does not approve any projects with fury. Please visit our website (<u>www.opsb.ohio.gov</u>) where you can find the statutory timelines which we have to adhere to. As far as "egregious setbacks" are concerned, the Board does not establish turbine setbacks. Rather, the Ohio legislature does. The first round of setback distances was established in Senate Bill 51. Setbacks were later increased in subsequent legislation.

The Ohio Power Siting Board very much takes note of public concerns, which is reflected in each and every case docket. The Board bases its decision on the full case record.
