Thanks. 19 (Witness excused.) 2.0 HEARING OFFICER JENNINGS: It's my 2.1 understanding that there are other exhibits you wish 22 to admit into the record? 23 MS. LESLIE: Yes, your Honor. At this 2.4 time Columbia would like to mark Columbia Exhibit 25 No. 1, which is the Notice of Intent to File an

9 Application to Adjust Rider IRP and Rider DSM Rates. 1 2 HEARING OFFICER JENNINGS: It shall be so 3 marked and admitted into the record. 4 (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 5 MS. LESLIE: Columbia respectfully 6 requests that the Application to Adjust Rider IRP and 7 Rider DSM Rates shall be marked as Columbia Exhibit 8 No. 2. 9 HEARING OFFICER JENNINGS: It will be 10 marked accordingly and admitted into the record. 11 (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 12 MS. LESLIE: Columbia requests that the 13 prepared direct testimony of John Laverty be marked as Columbia Exhibit No. 3. 14 HEARING OFFICER JENNINGS: It will be 15 16 marked and admitted into the record. 17 (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 18 HEARING OFFICER JENNINGS: In fact, I 19 will just have you walk through the exhibits, 2.0 identify them, and I will admit them at the end. 2.1 MS. LESLIE: Great. 22
