- (1) By Opinion and Order issued August 15, 2012, in *In re Application of Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.*, Case No. 11-4393-El-RDR, the Commission approved a stipulation entered into between Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) and some of the parties. Specifically, inter alia, the Commission approved Duke's Rider Energy Efficiency and Demand Response (EE/PDR) for the recovery of program costs, lost distribution revenue, and performance incentives related to Duke's energy efficiency and demand response programs.
- (2) On March 28, 2014, as revised on April 17, 2014, Duke filed the instant case requesting Commission approval to adjust Rider EE-PDR to recover costs related to compliance with energy efficiency mandates.
- (3) In order to accomplish the review of Duke's application, the attorney examiner finds that the following procedural schedule should be established:
 - (a) June 17, 2014 Deadline for the filing of motions to intervene.
 - (b) June 17, 2014 Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by Staff and intervenors.
 - (c) July 1, 2014 Deadline for all parties to file reply comments.
