## **NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY**

AEP Ohio Transmission Company (AEP Ohio Transcol has proposed to relocate the existing Summerfield-Texas Eastern Berne 138-kilovolt (kY) transmission line into a now switching sta-tion on property owned by AEP Ohio Transco in Franklin Township in Monroe County

The purpose of the Summer field-Toxas Eastern Berne 138-kV Transmission Line Relocation and Installation of the Blue Racer Station Project is to provide adequate levels of electricity to Blue Racer Midstream. LLC The project involves constructing a 15 acre station end relocation of existing transmission lines on new single circuit steel poles. This project will be an exprosumesta 315 million investment by AEP in its transmission system. Construction is scheduled to begin in September 2014.

The project is known as the Summerfield-Taxes Eastern Reme 138-tV Transmission Line Neto-cation and installation of the Blue Racer Sta-tion Project. As required by Ohno Revised Code Sociola 4090-11-101, AEP Ohio Transco has fide a Lotter of Notification with the Ohio Power String Board, under Case No. 14-0530-Et-BLN This number should be included in all commu-nications with respect to this proceeding. The project is known as the Summerfield-Texas



- In the case of electric transmission lines, that the facility is consistent with regional pleas for expansion of the electric power grid of the electric systems serving Ohio and interconnected systems, and that the facility will save the interests of electric system economy and reliability.

  The facility will comply with chapters
  3704, 3734 and 5111 of the Revised Code
  and all rules and standards adopted under
  sections 1501.33, 1501.34 and 4551.32 of
  the Revised Code. In determining whether
